


Risk Assessment: Event/Activity

Using this template, you should risk assess activities, trips and events in line with Girlguiding's Risk Assessment Policy. Using the information on the website and this cover page, you should be able to identify effective risk management strategies and tasks to ensure that activities run safely and effectively.

For more information or support with risk assessments, please speak to your local commissioner.

- Hazards are anything that has the potential to cause harm (e.g. cars, trip hazards, exposed electrical wires, theft, etc.).
- Risk is the likelihood of something happening, combined with the severity of the harm that could be caused by one or more hazards

Risk management is a dynamic cycle that needs to be repeated in order to effectively manage risk. The frequency of reassessment will depend on activity, and new risks could occur that have not previously been assessed. In this instance, a dynamic risk assessment is required.

Activity lead led sessions: The visiting group is responsible for having a suitably qualified 1st aider and a 1st aid kit. 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Participant turning round with bow/ arrow drawn	All - injury	Range rules explained at start of session. Clearly defined area for shooting range. Activity lead led sessions: The visiting group is responsible for having a suitably qualified 1st aider and a 1st aid kit. Overshoot	All - injury	Target position/ range layout guidance adhered to. Instructor led sessions: Instructor trained in 1st aid and 1st aid kit taken to each session. Holding arrows unsafely when walking back	Participants	Group briefed on ensuring arrows carried safely. Awareness that nock end is more dangerous than the sucker end. Setting up the equipment	Instructor, activity lead or Deer park team - injury	Ensure safe lifting and moving equipment for both set up and take down of range. 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 Sunburn Hypothermia Hyperthermia 	All	instructor/ activity lead to check weather forecast prior to activity and observe conditions throughout. If necessary, change plans. Ensure participants have suitable and adequate clothing including sun protection. Reminders to drink plenty during extreme heat. Instructor led sessions: Instructor trained in 1st aid and 1st aid kit taken to each session. Activity lead led sessions: The visiting group is responsible for having a suitably qualified 1st aider and a 1st aid kit. 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Wasps	All - Stings	A check for the presence of wasp nests should be done prior to any session. Any evidence of a nest should be reported to the Deer Park team as soon as possible and an alternative location can be sought for the activity. Lack of 1 st aid provision	All - worsening injury	Instructor led sessions: Instructor trained in 1st aid and 1st aid kit taken to each session. Activity lead led sessions: The visiting group is responsible for having a suitably qualified 1st aider and a 1st aid kit.	Low	Low		Group leader - prior to the activity starting
